Course Description

Start by the

A420 at the eastern litter sign in the long lay-by just east of the Kingston Bagpuize by-pass roundabout with A415.

Proceed west along A420 onto the dual carriageway by-pass and continue to the roundabout with the A415, (Care of traffic crossing on A415) Take the second exit to continue straight on along A420

Take second exit at roundabout with A417 to continue straight ahead on A420

Take first exit at roundabout with A417 to continue straight ahead on A420

Take fourth exit at Watchfield roundabout to return back on A420

Take second exit at roundabout with A417 to continue straight ahead on A420

Take first exit at roundabout with A417 to continue straight ahead on A420

Take third exit at roundabout with A415 to return west on A420 to repeat lap to Watchfield roundabout and back.

Take second exit at roundabout with A415 to continue straight ahead on A420

Finish at western litter sign in layby immediately west of Tubney Wood

Marshals referred to in this course description (M1, M2) etc may be provided solely to indicate the course direction.

They have no role whatsoever in the risk assessment itself.

Riders attention to be raised to traffic movement at time of their start. Riders waiting to start must keep off highway.
3	RAB at junction of A420 and A415		Traffic on A415 heading in each direction being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on A415 North and South of RAB to alert drivers
4	RAB at junction of A420 and A417 Stanford Road		Traffic on A417 Stanford Road heading toward RAB being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on A417 Stanford Road to alert drivers
5	RAB at junction of A420 and A417 Park Road		Traffic on A417 Park Road heading toward RAB being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on A417 Park Road to alert drivers
6	TURN RAB at junction of A420 with B4508 Majors Rd from East, Faringdon Rd from South and A420 from West		Traffic heading toward RAB on each road being unaware of cycling event.	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on each road approaching RAB to alert drivers. Provide safety marshal on North West of RAB adjacent to bypass lane to alert riders if necessary.
7	Finish		Danger from passing vehicles	LOW	All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments. A finish chequer board or flag is to be displayed at finish. It must be fixed to ensure it is not affected by passing traffic. Riders to continue past finish without stopping to turn at RAB at junction with A338 if wishing to retrace Westwards or towards HQ
	Wherever placing or removing signs		Danger from passing vehicles	MEDIUM	Be very vigilant of traffic conditions It is strongly recommended that sign erectors wear Hi-Viz upper garments complying with BS EN 1150, BS EN 471 or ISO EN 20471:2013
