START 10 yards West of junction of Dancers End Lane and Upper Icknield Way (B4009), 3 ½ yards east of telegraph pole. Head south-west on Upper Icknield Way for 0.72 miles then turn LEFT onto Aston Hill. Continue straight for 0.73 miles to FINISH located 26 yards south of entrance to Aston Hill Farm on verge on left.

Marshals referred to in this course description (M1, M2) etc may be provided solely to indicate the course direction. They have no role whatsoever in the risk assessment itself.

Riders attention to be raised to traffic movement at time of their start. Riders waiting to start must keep off highway .
2	Junction of London Road and Upper Icknield Way		Traffic turning into Upper Icknield Way from London Road being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on London Rd on each side of junction to alert drivers. Place safety marshal in Hi Viz upper garment at junction to alert drivers.
3	Junction of Dancers End Lane and Upper Icknield Way		Traffic turning into Upper Icknield Way from Dancers End Lane being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on Dancers End Lane approaching junction to alert drivers. Place safety marshal in Hi Viz upper garment at junction to alert drivers.
4	Junction of Dancers End Lane and Stablebridge Road		Traffic turning into Upper Icknield Way from Stablebridge Road being unaware of cycling event	LOW	Place warning sign on Stablebridge Road approaching junction to alert drivers.
	Finish		Danger from passing vehicles	LOW	All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to continue past finish without stopping . A finish chequer board or flag is to be displayed at finish. It must be fixed to ensure it is not affected by passing traffic.
	Wherever placing or removing signs		Danger from passing vehicles	MEDIUM	Be very vigilant of traffic conditions It is strongly recommended that sign erectors wear Hi-Viz upper garments complying with BS EN 1150, BS EN 471 or ISO EN 20471:2013
