Course Description

763430 Start at a point at the end of the lay-by on the south side of the A31, just after the 400 yards to single lane sign. As the lay-by begins to narrow. 0
Join the A31 and continue to the Holybourne roundabout
736403 Circle the roundabout and take the third exit back onto the A31 to retrace, going through Froyle and along the Bentley by-pass to continue past the (former) 'The Bull' public House to the Coxbridge roundabout at the junction with the A325 (Turn) 2.479
828459 Circle the roundabout and take the fourth exit back onto the A31 to retrace along the Bentley by-pass past the start point (14.294 miles) to go to the Holybourne roundabout (Turn) 9.682
REPEAT AS FOLLOWS.
736403 Holybourne roundabout. (Turn) 16.773
828459 Coxbridge roundabout. (Turn) 23.976
736403 Holybourne roundabout. 31.067
828459 Coxbridge roundabout. (Turn) 38.270
736403 Holybourne roundabout (Turn) 45.361
794441 Continue along the A31 past the Bentley turn off to a point 24 yards after the 600 yards to single lane sign (five uprights on the armco or two cats eyes back from the national speed limit sign) where finish 50

Course History

There have been two serious incidents, seven years apart, on a section of the A31 covered by this course, the first was in 2015 and a second in 2022. Both drivers were subsequently convicted of serious driving offences. There is no suggestion that either of the cyclists involved, nor the course design was in any way at fault.

1	Start	Traffic passing riders waiting to start	MEDIUM	Place warning sign before start. All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to wear Hi Viz numbers on their backs. Riders attention to be raised to traffic movement at time of their start. Riders waiting to start must keep off highway .
2	Holybourne rbt at junctions with A31 and B3004	Traffic approaching rbt from A31 and B3004 being unaware of cycling event.	MEDIUM	Place warning signs on A31 and B3004 approaching roundabout to alert drivers.
3	Coxbridge (Farnham) rbt at junctions with A325 (Farnham), A31 (Farnham bypass) and A325 (Wrecclesham)	Traffic approaching rbt from A325, A31 and A325 being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning signs on A325(Farnham) A31(Farnham ByPass and A325(Wrecclesham) approaching roundabout to alert drivers.
4	Finish	Danger from passing vehicles	LOW	All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to continue past finish without stopping . A finish chequer board or flag is to be displayed at finish. It must be fixed to ensure it is not affected by passing traffic.
	Wherever placing or removing signs	Danger from passing vehicles	MEDIUM	Be very vigilant of traffic conditions It is strongly recommended that sign erectors wear Hi-Viz upper garments complying with BS EN 1150, BS EN 471 or ISO EN 20471:2013

Side road junctions, the small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garages, cafés etc) that are not mentioned in this risk assessment have been considered, they are not considered significant to pose a risk and therefore have not been noted.
